

Cookie STATEMENT

1. What are cookies?

Cookies are small data files sent by a web server and stored on your device when you visit a website. While attempting to open the corresponding web page, the web browser sends this piece of data to the web server. Cookies are used to ensure or improve the performance of the website, to determine the preferences of website visitors, and to display advertisements.

We can use both cookies set directly by us and cookies set by a third-party provider on our behalf.

The cookies files information is stored in a format that does not personally identify you and they cannot be disclosed to third parties outside of our company. This information will not be unauthorizedly transfer to third parties.

2. What cookies do we use and why?

Strictly Necessary Cookies are required for the website to function properly and cannot be disabled on our systems.

Analytics cookies are set by a web analytics service (for example, Google Analytics, Yandex Metrika) and collect information about how visitors use the website and which pages are most often visited. They allow us to count the number of visitors and traffic sources in order to measure and improve the performance of our website.

Targeting and Advertising Cookies are set on the site by our advertising partners such as Weborama. These companies may use them to profile your interests and display relevant advertisements on other websites.

Social media cookies are set by social media services (e.g. Instagram, Facebook) that we have added to our website. These cookies are used to enable you to share the pages that interest you and the content of our websites through social networks. These cookies also allow us to serve advertising to those who are interested in our brand/product on social media.

3. How long will cookies be stored on my device?

The storage time of cookies on your device depends on whether they are “persistent” or “session”. Persistent cookies are stored in the web browser and remain valid until their expiration date (unless deleted by the user until then). Session cookies expire when the user's session ends after closing the web browser.

4. How can I control cookies?
